NEW STEM SETUP FOR RIVERINA ANGLICAN COLLEGE

The Riverina Anglican College will get a \$1 million grant from the NSW Government to build a science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) facility at the school.

The NSW Government grant will go towards the school's \$3.6 million project that includes seven classrooms, four science labs, an outdoor learning area and staff room.

Member for Wagga Wagga Daryl Maguire welcomed the NSW Government funding, which will be provided under the Building Grants Assistance Scheme.

"Our local students need and deserve the best education we can provide them," Mr Maguire said.

"Projects like this help provide that top-quality education, and I'm pleased the NSW Government is helping to fund this project."

Education Minister Rob Stokes said the NSW Government was working hard to deliver the school facilities students needed.

"We want to provide high quality education facilities to all students, regardless of what school they go to, so they can succeed and thrive in the 21st century," Rob Stokes said.

The BGAS grant for The Riverina Anglican College is part of a \$33 million NSW Government program directed towards independent and Catholic schools with the greatest need, to help them cater for growing enrolments and refurbish or build new facilities.

The grants help schools improve the learning environments for their students, giving schools contemporary facilities that reflect modern learning needs.
